Volunteer Client Advocate – Level 1

The client advocate will be well trained to greet clients and sit across from young women who come for the **day time parenting classes or baby and maternity items**. Client advocate has the role of facilitating them to watch educational videos, answer a questionnaire on the same, and discuss issues she may want to talk about.

Training is provided at CPC. Compassion and understanding for women from all walks of life are needed. This is a weekly commitment.

Volunteer Client Advocate – Level 2

The client advocate will be well trained to greet clients and sit across from those who are coming for a **pregnancy test**. It is the role of the client advocate to complete an intake form with the client, perform and read the pregnancy test, and discuss her options concerning the pregnancy with her.

Training is provided at CPC. Compassion and understanding for women in unplanned pregnancy are needed. This is a weekly commitment.

Maintenance

Cleaning/organizing office; picking up trash; repairing minor issues.



Sorting Donations

Volunteers are needed to sort through donations received at CPC. These may include:

- Baby clothing
- Maternity clothing
- Other Baby related items



Help with Events

Help is sometimes needed for our yearly events.

Events include:

- Change for Life (baby bottle fundraiser)
- Celebrate Life Banquet

Refreshments for Night Parenting Classes

Night parenting classes are held twice per year for five sessions each for our clients who are expecting their first child. Refreshments are needed for our participants and include a light dinner during our class time. We encourage volunteers to combine with a small group of friends to provide one night of refreshments.

Administrative Support

Occasionally, we need help with labeling brochures, folding and sorting large mailouts, and counting change from baby bottles.
